

OFFICIAL RULES

“Yaquina Run-Off” Race

We wish to keep this a FUN event for all, where SAFETY is first and foremost. This is an annual event. Therefore, we appreciate your input & feedback to help us make next year’s event even more successful. Please note that there will be no refunds for any reason. The race will take place RAIN or SHINE.

1. Coast Guard-approved PFD’s should be worn at all times. Participants should also be mindful of OSMB & Coast Guard boating safety regulations.
2. A parent or guardian must accompany those under the age of 18 and sign a waiver prior to race start time.
3. For tandem teams, both participants must check in together. Registration is from 9 am to 10:30 a.m. at the Port of Toledo Information Booth. The long course racers will start at 11:00 am, short course racers at 11:15 a.m., all at Pork Dock One. There will be a mandatory safety briefing at the bandstand at 10:30 a.m.
4. Boat numbers will be issued at registration and must be visible on the starboard (right) side of the boat, especially when crossing the finish line.
5. Participants are required to use good judgment and to assist anyone in jeopardy as a result of capsizing. There will be safety patrol boats along the race route and they must be given the right of way.
6. NO ALCHOLIC BEVERAGES ARE ALLOWED AT THE BOAT LAUNCH AREA OR ON THE BOATS DURING THE RACE.
7. Officials and judges reserve the right to make all decisions in regard to any part of this event and their decisions are final.
8. Awards will be available at the Port Information Booth at 2:30 PM. Final results will be posted at the Port Booth.
