**Resolution 2022-1**

**WHEREAS** eleven Aluminum gangways of various lengths were purchased by the Port through the State Surplus program in 2017 with the original intention to use as catwalks in the planned environmental work building;

**WHEREAS**, it was determined, through the building design process, that use of the gangways as catwalks was not feasible;


**WHEREAS**, the Port has limited need for replacement gangways. The gangways are not designed for ADA accessibility, and therefore not acceptable for use at the Marina;

**WHEREAS** the gangways are currently in storage at the Industrial Complex with no plans for use.


**And WHEREAS**, the Port has met all State Surplus retainage obligations.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, by the Board of Commissioners for the Port of Toledo, that up to 7 aluminum gangways of various lengths are hereby declared surplus to the needs of the district and offered for sale by the Port Manager in accordance with applicable law.
